



Community Heart Safe

For Horton, Oxwich, Oxwich Green & Surrounding Areas

Defibrillators/AEDs are used in cases of suspected heart attack: to monitor heart rhythms and where appropriate deliver a shock.

Defibrillators/AEDs accessible to everyone are being provided locally with funding from the Penrice Community Council and the Big Lottery and the support of the Fire & Rescue Service and the Village Hall Committees. Some are provided by local businesses. Although the devices can be used without prior knowledge the organisers encourage everyone to be prepared by taking up the free local training.



Defibrillators will be available at:

Upper Horton: Village Hall & Bank Farm Caravan Park

Lower Horton: Sea Breeze (which is near the post box)

Oxwich: Community Hall & Oxwich Bay Hotel

Oxwich Green: Greenways Leisure Park
